Limestone is a natural rock, formed deep in the earth, limestone is quarried in huge blocks, and sliced, then polished on one face. Limestone Kitchen Worktops are porous and require a little maintenance. This will give you natural beauty, and a one off look, as every piece of limestone is different. You should be prepared for some natural variations, and a little work to keep it's high gloss polish.

Limestone requires sealing, every 3-12 months dependent on colour, lighter colours require more regular sealing. We recommend the use of a quality stone sealer. Limestone is perfect where looks are more important than use.
